



The "Areas Passing(%)" report shows the percentage of areas that met your predefined expectations during the inspections. An increasing percentage (up trend on the chart) indicates that your expectations are being met more often.



The "Landscape Defects Summary" report shows the total defect points deducted for the various conditions spotted. The higher a bar gets the more serious the condition is across the site. Blue bars represent current, gray bars represent past inspections.



The "Landscape Defects" report shows the observed conditions for each inspection area. Conditions are indicated with gray, dark gray and black colors, representing slight, moderate and severe conditions. An area (a row on report) with more conditions has lower quality.

The "Work Orders" report shows a listing of the observed moderate and severe conditions on the site. Conditions are listed in the order of severety. This report is designed to be used by landscape contractors to assign the high priority tasks to the crews.

1	Turf: - Mow and edge weekly - Broadleaf weed control			
2	Ground Cover: - Edge as needed - Remove weeds			
3	Trees and Shrubs: - Prune trees and shrubs for size control - Give acid fertilizer to acid loving plants - Spot treatment for weeds			
4	Flowers: - Remove faded flowers and dead leaves - Apply metaldehyde and diazinon granules - Fertilize			
5	Irrigation: - Check sprinklers for misalignments, sunken heads and coverage - Check valves for leaks and proper operation			
6	Integrated Pest Management: - Monitor for aphids, scale and psyllids - Monitor for snails and slugs in ivy and gazania - Monitor for gophers - Monitor for tulip tree aphids on liriodendron - Monitor for flatheaded borers in alders			
7	Water Management: - Program irrigation controllers according soil moisture (probe as necessary)			
8	General: - Pickup and remove leaf litter - Blow building entrances and walks
